ABOUT VEOLIA IN DELAWARE

Veolia owns and operates a single continuous drinking water system serving a population of over 100,000 people in North New Castle County, Delaware. The system includes over 550 miles of water main and a 30 million gallon per day water treatment plant sourced from surface water supplied by the Red Clay and White Clay Creeks. The plant's average daily demand is 14.5 million gallons and maximum daily demand of 19.3 million gallons. Since 2017, Veolia has invested over \$92 million in capital improvements to maintain and upgrade plant systems and replace aging infrastructure through an annual main renewal program.
